OVERVIEW

Delete Order Magento Extension enables the user to delete orders.

Magento doesn't allow you to delete orders. You can only mark it to canceled but you can't delete it. This extension allows you to delete order in back end seamlessly through the Action drop down box on the native Order Manager.

The extension is easy to install and use. The Order Delete Extension is Lightweight, fulfills the task with minimum obstruction and is in line with the Magento Standard Work flow.

Features

- Easy to delete order in back end seamlessly through the Action drop down box on the native Order Manager.
- Requires no manual configuration.
- Easy installation.
- Meets Magento programming guidelines.
- 100% open source.

Installation Steps

1. Clear the store cache under **var/cache** and all cookies for your store domain.
2. Disable compilation for Magento 1.4+. Log into Magento **Admin Panel** and go to **System → Tools → Compilation** and disable the compilation.

Installation Steps

3. Disable JS & CSS merging

Navigate to System->Configuration->Developer Tab and disable "Merge css / js". We suggest that you enable error reporting.

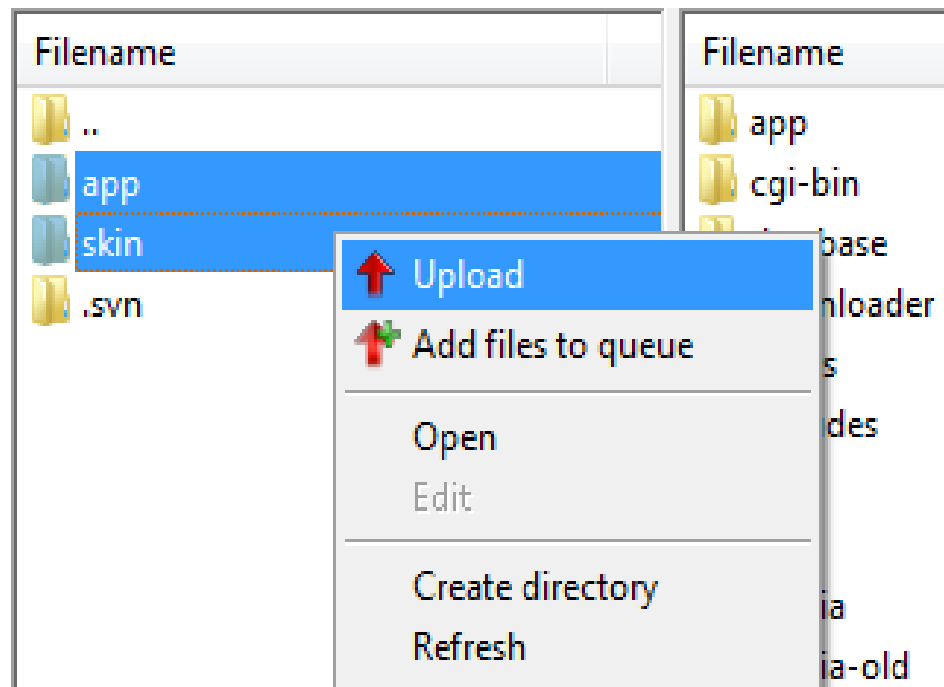

5. Clear Cache
