If you have big and light items, shipping calculators could charge more than needed. Also when shipping to specific countries (e.g. Iceland, Canada, etc) or using drop shippers, shipping costs could differ a lot, which makes table rates almost useless. This is where our Magento shipping per product extension comes into play - with it you can indicate individual shipping rate for each product and be sure that the right amount is charged for shipping.

Features

There are different Features of this extension as below:

- Now its time to farewell wrong and automated shipping price calculators.
- This magento promotion extension will help to display individual flat shipping rates per product.
- You can utilize default pricing for the products without individual rates distinct.
- The extension can add calculation handling fee based on fixed and percentage rates.
- Compatible with Magento Community Edition 1.9 and Enterprise Edition 1.14.
- Capability to stipulate least and maximum margins.

Installation Steps

1. Clear the store cache under **var/cache** and all cookies for your store domain.
2. Disable compilation for Magento 1.4+. Log into Magento **Admin Panel** and go to **System → Tools → Compilation** and **disable** the compilation.

3. Disable JS & CSS merging

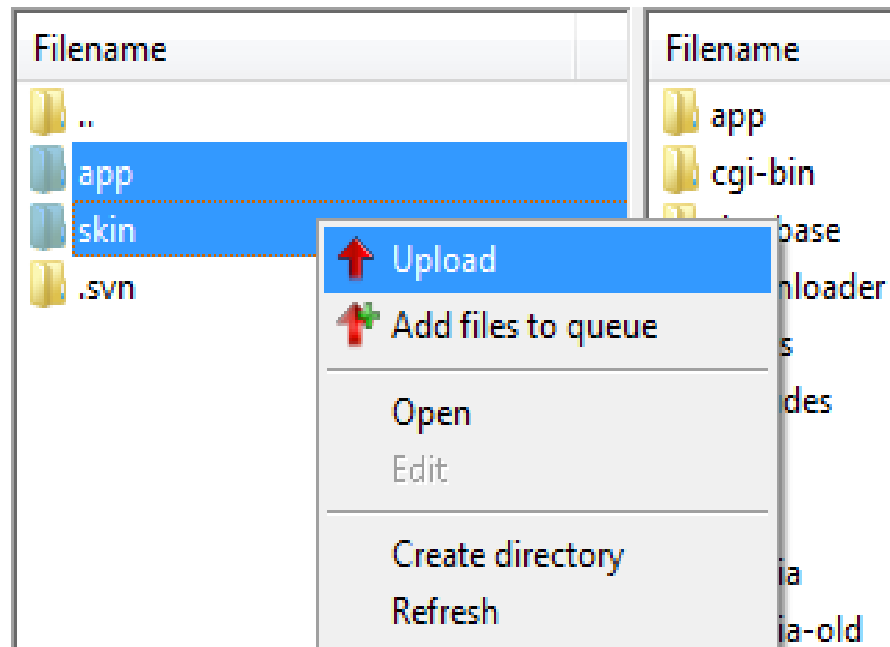
Navigate to System->Configuration->Developer Tab and disable "Merge css / js". We suggest that you enable error reporting.

If you use a different from default theme - be sure to rename **app/design/frontend/default/default** and **skin/frontend/default/default** folders to your store's values. Using your FTP client upload content to your store root.

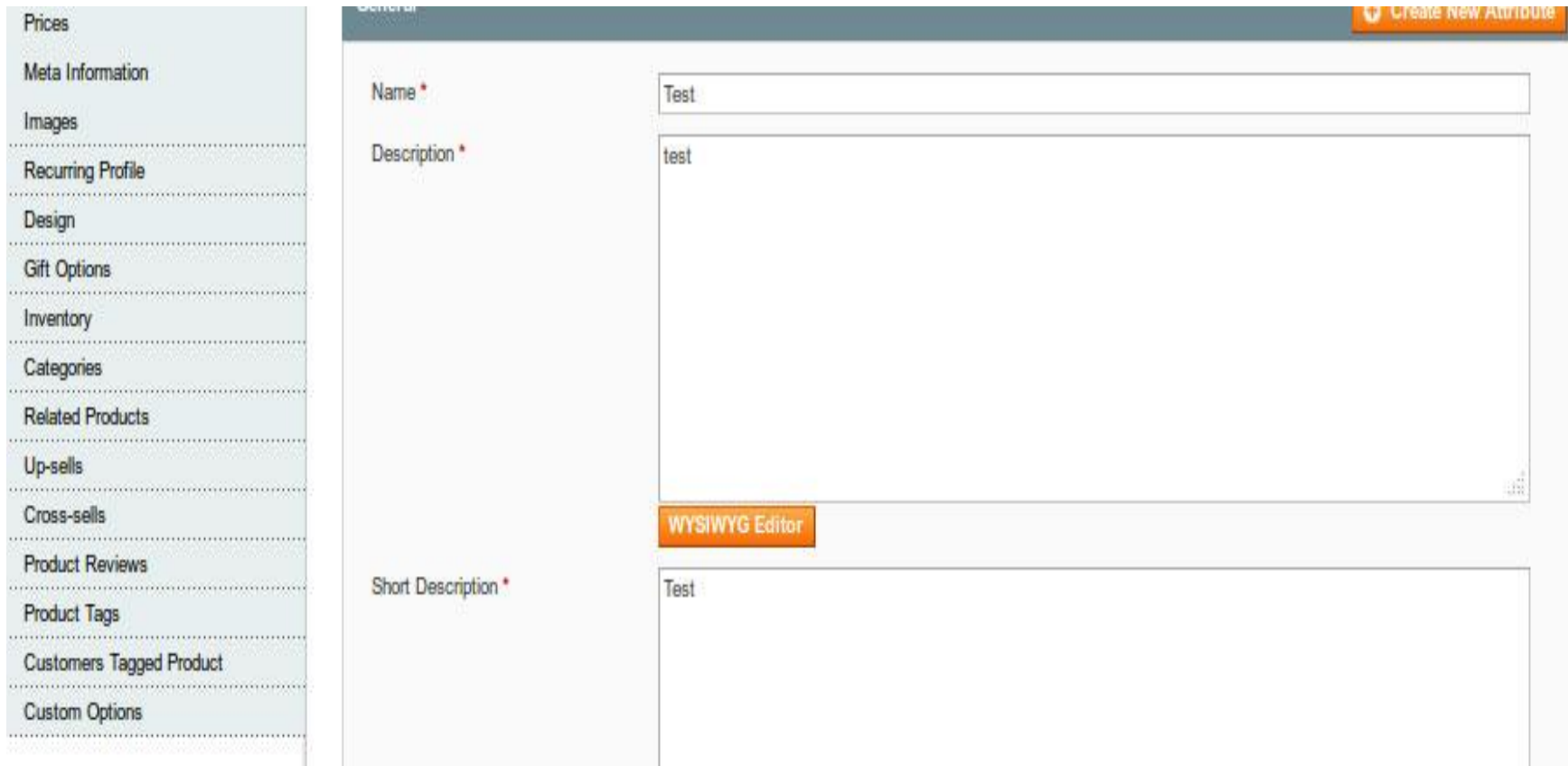

How to Setup new Shipping Method

1. Set Enabled to ' Yes ' if want to activate this shipping method.
2. You can specify default shipping rate.
3. Set ' Use Default Value' to 'Yes ' to use the default rate for all products, for which individual rate wasn't specified.
4. You can indicate Minimal and Maximal Shipping rates. Please be aware that minimum and maximum apply to Whole Order, not for individual item.
5. If you set Calculate each item separately to 'No' then Customer will pay the shipping amount of a product regard to the product quantity.

How to Specify Shipping Rate for Each Product

You Can set individual shipping rate for each product when creating new product or editing existing one in admin panel. This will help to handle heavy, lightweight or fragile items properly. Please check the below screenshot.


